After six years as Chair of the Operation Cleft Australia Inc. Board, and four years previously as Secretary, Bruce hands over the mantle of OCA leadership to new Chair, Kath Ronan. Bruce reflects on six years in leadership of this nearly 20-year-old 'life changing' program — bringing hope, health, and a smile, through the provision of more than 20,000 free Cleft-lip and pallet surgeries to the Cleft suffering, poor and disadvantaged children of Bangladesh.

'Bruce Reflections': These past six years have been up there as some of the most significant and fulfilling years of my life. To be part of a dedicated (Rotary backed) volunteer team, committed to providing this life changing program, has been a privilege and joy, beyond what I could have ever hoped for.

These are the things that have brought a smile to my face over these past six years:

The many Children whose lives and faces have been transformed. The stories and pictures of Mums and Dads in tears of joy, overwhelmed by the change and a future made possible through the skills of our dedicated Cleft surgery team

The different stories and backgrounds of our six, highly skilled, deeply committed surgeons, each one totally devoted to providing free, often complex 'Maxillofacial' plastic surgery for their fellow Bangladeshi children, whose families could not ever afford such surgery.

Working with Moinul Islam, an enthusiastic, bright, and talented young Bangladeshi who I first met in 2014, when he commenced as OCA's Bangladesh In-country Manager, providing the important liaison with our local BD NGO, surgeons, and hospitals. Moinul migrated to Australia in 2018, works for the City of Greater Geelong, yet continues to serve on the OCA Board as our OCA Goodwill Ambassador and produces this newsletter. (Continues)

I have also deeply appreciated working with our 'Cleft Bangladesh' staff in Bangladesh and our local NGO, SNAD Inc.

Also working together with our Partner DCKH (Deutsch Cleft Kinderhilfe e.V) has been a highlight. In 2018 Operation Cleft Australia Inc. entered into a collaborative agreement with DCKH, a German based non-for-profit organisation with experience providing Cleft Lip and Pallet surgery support in more than a dozen Asian, African, and South American countries. It's been a delight to work with such an experienced partner, share resources and thereby effectively minimise in-country administrative costs.

I am deeply appreciative of the many other things that have made me smile!

These include the faithful, overwhelming support of you, our broad family of supportive donor partners here in Australia. It's your faithfulness in giving that has made 'smiles' possible for the Cleft suffering children across Bangladesh. Thanks to our Board members and our many other volunteers for the support and for sharing the load and for the many committed members and friends within Rotary Club's and the broader Rotary world, particularly the members of the Rotary Club of Box Hill Central and staff at the Club's Recycle Shop. Kath Ronan our new Operation Cleft Australia Chair (I continue to serve her and our Board as the Deputy Chair) is a fellow member of the Rotary Club of Box Hill Central.

Kath has been serving on our Board since 2018 and as Deputy Chair since 2022. Kath brings many years of clinical and medical experience to the role.

Kath will lead the up-coming self-funded visit to Bangladesh in late May. This will be our first visit post Covid. Moinul has organised for the eight of us to visit 4 Clinics in four major centres, visit several Rotary Clubs, meet the children and their parents undergoing Surgery, including involvement at one Clinic in Cox's Bazar, where the Clinic will be made up of Cleft suffering Children from the huge UNA Rohingya Refugee camp (more than one million refugees) situated close by. I will continue as Deputy Chair, supporting Kath and the Board. Thanks for the amazing encouragement support and affirmations shared with me over my six years as Chair. Again, thanks for making 'the Gift of a Smile" such an amazing reality for so many children.

Operation Cleft Implements Safer Anesthesia for Patient Safety


Operation Cleft is proud to announce a significant step forward in ensuring the safety of our young patients undergoing cleft lip and palate surgeries in Bangladesh. In collaboration with DCKH and our local partners, we've decided to prohibit the use of Halothane—an anaesthetic associated with safety concerns. In the future, we will be using Isoflurane as an anaesthetic drug in all our surgeries.

We extend our gratitude to our surgeons for prioritising patient safety above all else. This transition underscores our commitment to excellence in patient care at Operation Cleft.

As always, the well-being of our patients remains our top priority. We're excited to continue our mission with renewed dedication, ensuring safe and effective cleft surgeries for children in need.


